

Test Procedure

1. Point one of the approved browsers to connect to <https://vlabs.hpe.com/> and click the “Log in to the Virtual Labs Gateway” link highlighted below in the “Access your lab” section.

4. select your keyboard type if it differs from the default and click SIGN IN.


